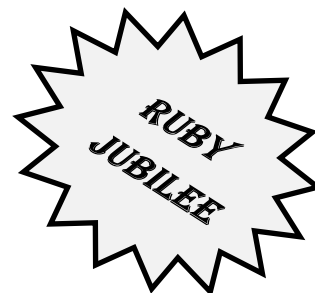

Filling Out the Quilt Entry Form: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Each form is for one entry. If you are doing several entries, consider doing them online – put in your name & address only once! Please print CLEARLY and double check! Choose a Drop-Off location from the list below and write it on the entry form. That person will have a receipt ready for you. Make sure you check the CORRECT category on your entry form. See below for notes about the categories. Fill in the name of your quilt and state the accurate size in WHOLE inches. If you put 87 ¼, it will become 88. If your quilt size grows, please contact Kathy (see above). Accurate measurements are critical for planning the layout for the show. Mail the first/top page to: Kathy Bradstreet, 10803 E 31st Ave, Spokane, WA 99206; the second page of the form is your copy. Must be postmarked by Sunday, August 12 !! 	Prepping the quilt for the show: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Write the word “top” on a piece of muslin and slip stitch it to the top, center back of your quilt. Label each quilt with your name, address and phone number on muslin stitched to the lower, left back of entry. Place each quilt in a SEPARATE CLEAR OR WHITE PLASTIC BAG that does not need to be returned. Dropping off the quilt, and picking it up after the show: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Your drop-off choice on the front of the entry form is needed so your quilt bag label and receipt will be ready for you at that location. Drop offs are from Saturday, Oct 6 through Saturday, Oct 13 at the location you put on the entry form. When you Drop-Off your quilt, your bag is labeled and you get a receipt for it. You will need the receipt for pick up after the show. Pick up your quilt on Sunday, Oct.21 between 6:00-7:00 pm at the Fairgrounds (404 N. Havana, Spokane, WA)

Ribbons
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ribbons will not be awarded to quilts entered into an incorrect category, as determined by the quilt show committee. WSQ Ribbons will be awarded to the top 3 winning entries in each category before the show opens on Sunday. INMQ Ribbons will be voted on by INMQ members only. Optional Judging is separate from ribbons.
Category Information
Size: If a category does not have a specific size range, it can be any size. Size is calculated by adding together the lengths of all 4 sides.
Machine Quilting Categories, Solo & Duo Determination If a quilt is Made By and Quilted By the same name, it will be in the Solo category; if not, it will be in the Duo category. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Modern Quilt: For example: contemporary, bold, colorful, modern design, asymmetrical, expansive negative space. Machine Quilted, Combination: has piecing, applique and/or embroidery, but no computerized stitching. Machine Quilted, Computer Aided: Any portion quilted by computer goes in this category even if balance was freehand quilted. Machine Quilted, Freehand: No computerized or digital quilting used.
Themes & Techniques <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Computerized Machine Embroidery and/or Appliqued: Any design, applique or embroidery, using a computerized machine. Fabric Art Quilt: Must be entirely original in design. Quilted Small Home Decor, Wearable Art: Item must be quilted. Examples: table runners, miniature quilts, pillows, or quilted clothing. No wall hangings. Juvenile Theme: Quilts specifically intended for young, juvenile person; baby quilt, crib quilt, etc. Novelty: Does not fit neatly into another category. Examples: yo-yo, T-shirt, tied, some group challenges.
Group Quilts & Challenges <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Group Quilt, Round Robin Quilt: One quilt made by three or more people. WSQ Challenge: Limited to WSQ Members only as per packet instructions purchased at quarterly meetings. INMQ Challenge & Treasure Challenge: Limited to INMQ Members only.
