Hands-on workshop to learn basic cleaning, oiling and greasing procedures for your Singer Featherweight sewing machine. We will NOT cover, or help with, motor or wiring issues.

THINGS TO BRING:

- * Your Featherweight machine
- * Newspaper-couple of pages
- * Old small towel, or very soft cloth (to set your machine on while working on it)
- * Disposable latex or nitrile gloves (to keep your hands clean!)
- * Old rags or paper towels to get dirty and toss.
- * Q-Tips
- * Tweezers (narrow sharp pointed types are best)
- * Flathead screwdrivers (2-3 sizes (1/8", 3/16", 1/4" smallest to largest), if you have them)
- * Sewing Machine Oil (NOT 3-in-1 household oil, shop oil or WD-40) you want good sewing machine oil
- * Singer motor lubricant/grease
- * Old toothbrush
- * Small natural-bristle brush
- * Small Flashlight
- * Sharpie permanent marker to mark hand-wheel clutch-washer alignment
- * Bring your 221 Featherweight manual, if you have one.
