QUILTING BEE BLOCK: HOW I SPENT MY SUMMER VACATION

Show us how you spent your summer vacation with a novelty fabric made into an old time snapshot. What fabric depicts how you spent your summer? Lynda Burns designed a block that is a snap to make.

You will need:

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|----------------------------|--------------------------|
| 7” block of novelty fabric | 2 white strips 9” x 1 ½” |
| 4 black squares 2 1/4” | 2 white strips 7” x 1 ½” |

Sew 7” white strips to the sides of your novelty square. Sew the 9” strips to the top & bottom of the novelty square. Trim your block so that you have exactly ¾” of white border on all four sides; your block is 8” square. Fold the black squares in half diagonally & press. Place a pressed triangle, with the folded edge facing the block center, in each corner and baste at 1/8” to create the photo corners.

WARNING: These are quick, fun and addictive!!!! Any questions, call Mari at 443-2319

Add two 9” strips, trim each white border to 3/4” each (all 4 sides)

Fold black squares. Iron & baste down 1/8” from edge

Add two 7” white strips
